

# A Categorized, Annotated Bibliography of Executive Information Systems (1983-1992)

## **ABSTRACT**

Since its first appearance in the early 1980s, the concept of Executive Information System(EIS) has been widely used to meet the executives' information needs of the various business areas in developed countries. The use of EIS, however, is still in the beginning stage in Korea. Therefore, a comprehensive bibliography of EIS papers including theoretical articles and case studies could help EIS practitioners in Korea a lot.

The objective of this paper is to provide a groundwork for researchers in the area of EIS by discussing the current status and prospect of EIS. This paper reports and analyzes the nature, content and trends exhibited by EIS papers presented at the information technology-related journals, magazines and conference proceedings from 1983 through 1992. In addition, we categorize each paper according to the application areas. Also, based on the implication of the thorough review, we identify the future research direction of EIS.
