CCD Photometry of the Globular Cluster M71

BV CCD photometry of a metal-rich globular cluster M71 is presented. Observations were carried using the 2.2m telescope with 2048×2048 CCD on Mauna Kea in October 1994. The frames cover a region of the cluster from the center to r=3.5. Using the DAOPHOT CCD reduction package, we obtained Color-Magnitude Diagram(CMD) with a well defind main-sequence extending to V=23. A total of about 10,000 stars have been measured. We will discuss the characteristics of M71 CMD, and will compare this result with the CMD of 47 Tuc, a globular cluster of similar metallicity.
