

The robe-beetles in some wetlands from Korea

The wetland are reevaluated from wasteland to an important feature of land recently in Korea. There is no any reports on robe beetles from Korean wetlands so far. For this purposes, the staphylinids living in wetlands were investigated from 4 localities, Mujechi moor of Ulsan, and Mulyoungari swamp, Muljangorum swamp, and Dongsuak bog, of Chejudo.

As a result, 22 species of 8 subfamily was collected from 4 localities, each of 11 species from Mujechi moor, 3 species Mulyoungari swamp, 3 species Muljangorum swamp, and 7 species Dongsuak bog.

One new species named *Osorius mujechiensis* and 4 unrecorded from korea were idenfited through the investigation on wetlands.
