**A First Record in the World to Kill the Bullfrog by the Asian  
Toad from Korea (Amphibia:Ranidae and Bufonidae)**

During the copulation season of the Asian toad (*Bufo bufo gargarizans*), we could observe killing bullfrog (*Rana catesbeiana*) by the Asian toad at the small pond, located near Munkyeong-city, Prov. Kyungsangpuk-do, Korea. This phenomenon to kill bullfrogs by the Asian toads has been widely appeared at the ponds from the several areas in the Kyungsangpuk-do and Taegu, ;Kimchun, Kumi, Chungdo, Youngchum, Munkyeong, Kyungsan etc. It took about 20 hrs to 8 days to kill bullfrogs by the Asian toads from last of Febr. to the first of April. And from each ponds of about 0.6 ha in average, 100 - 200 bullfrogs were killed by the Asian toads. On dead bodies of the bullfrogs, we could confirm a blood vessel breakage and blood leaking of the eyes, a red spots on the skin, pushing out of the gut through anus. Although this unusual killing pattern only during the copulation season of the Asian toads apperared, it will be the most effective biological control technique in the world at present point, which it was not known any natural enemy to the bullfrog.
