Four Unrecorded and a Little Known Species of Family Noctuidae (Insecta; Lepidoptera) in Korea

Noctuidae of Korea were enumerated with 961 species by Kononenko *et al.*(1998), and recently, further 5 species were added by Sohn *et al.*. In the present study, four additional unrecorded and a little known species of Noctuidae are newly recognized from the Korean peninsula. Thus, the known Korean Noctuidae are 970 species. Newly recognized species including a little known species are following.

- 1. Catoblemma obliquisigna (Hampson) 지의꼬마밤나방(신칭)
- 2. Lithacodia virescens (Sugi) 귤빛쌍무늬꼬마밤나방(신칭)
- 3. Oligia ophiogramma (Esper) 반원무늬밤나방(신칭)
- 4. Anoratha costalis Moore 잠자리수염나방(신칭)
- 5. Spodoptera pectens Guenée 남방빗살수염밤나방(specimen were newly found)
