

Z 108     **A Revision of the Subfamily Linyphiinae Blackwall, 1859  
(Araneae, Linyphiidae) in Korea**

The Linyphiinae Blackwall, 1859 of the family Linyphiidae in Korea is revised 14 species, 3 genera with taxonomic key by recent Tanasevitch'(2000) systematics. A Korean history of the subfamily Linyphiinae is arranged and two species, Bathylinyphia major (Kulczynski, 1885), and Porrhomma hebescens (L. Koch, 1879) are recognized. Two species, Neriene kimyongkii (Paik, 1965), and N. jinjoensis Paik, 1991 would like to record only list because of loss of original specimens, and insufficient data and research.

Z 109     **A Revision of the Genus *Lysiteles* Simon, 1895  
(Araneae: Thomisidae) from Korea**

Two species, *L. coronatus* (Grube, 1861) and *L. maius* Ono, 1979 of the genus *Lysiteles* from Korea are revised with accurate illustrated and identification key. The latter species is newly recorded in the Korean spider fauna. These species can be easily identified by the position of copulatory canal in the genitalia of female and the shape of the embolus and retrolateral tibial apophysis in the palp of male.
