

1-7. A Taxonomic Study of Five *Mallota* Species from Korea (Diptera: Syrphidae).

Five Korean species of the genus *Mallota* Meigen are taxonomically studied: *Malloa analis* (Shiraki), *M. ambigua* (Shiraki), *M. dimorpha* (Shiraki), *M. tricolor* Loew, and *M. sp.-1*. Based on the Korean specimens of this genus, adult external structures including male genitalia are described and illustrated. Especially, we confirmed the identity of formerly confused *M. ambigua* and *M. dimorpha*. They are in similar size and shape but easily distinguished by the male genitalia and abdominal pattern.
