Abstract

KIGAM(Korea Institute of Geoscience and Mineral Resources) has finished to digitalize geological maps of 1/50,000 scales in 1999. This project is supported by the Korea Ministry of Information and Communication under the name of "Knowledge and Information Resources Management Project".
