Four types of damage are discussed, including severe coronal damage, pulpal involvement that necessitates endodontic treatment, loss of periodontal attachment, and loss of roots. Restoration of endodontically treated teeth will be presented, along with the limits of such treatment. This includes restoring pulpless teeth that require endodontic therapy AFTER placement of crowns or fixe partial dentures, including repair of access

openings, rebuilding abutments under retainers, and restoring margin-al integrity when damage extends beyond the original crown margins.

Preparations for periodontally weakened teeth deals with unfamiliar morphology when preparing and restoring molars with exposed furcations. When do we use root resections to save teeth, and when do we extract them and use implants.
