Revision of the Genus *Tisis* Walker in Philippines and Malaysia (Sarawak), with Description of Seven New Species (Lepidoptera, Lecithoceridae)

In the revision of the genus Tisis Walker in Philippines and Malaysia (Sarawak), Seven species are newly described: 3 species amabilis sp. nov.. sabhaensis sp. nov., and yasudai sp. nov., Sarawak, Malaysia; and 4 species, sophistica sp. nov., aurantiella sp. nov., and xantholepidos sp. nov. from Philippines. T. elegans (Snellen, 1903) is illustrated for the first time since it was described, and T. luteella (Snellen, 1903) is newly reported from Sarawak. General informations on the previously species, and external images of the three previously known species are first represented. Illustrations of the male and female genitalia of the new species and some little known species are given. Material examined in this study are mainly based on specimens collected by T Yasuda (1981) in Sarawak, Malaysia, and preserved in the Entomological Laboratory, University of Osaka Prefecture, and on the collection of the USNM, Wash. USA. A part of materials is based on the collection of the Zoological Museum, Cophenhagen, collected from Philippines in 1961, and collection the of the Museum fur Naturkunde on der Humboldt-Universitat Berlin, Germany, collected by W. Mey (1996) and Mey & Spiedel (1997).
