Two Species of Genus *Camptorhinus* Schönherr (Coleoptera: Curculionidae) New to Korea

This paper was made to describe the morphological feature of *Camptorhinus dorsalis* (Boisduval) and *Camptorhinus dorsalis* (Boisduval) and *Camptorhinus dorsalis* Morimoto to new fauna of Korea. Two species of the genus *Camptorhinus* Schönherr, 1825 have been recorded from Korea(Illustrated Catalogue of Curculionidae in Korea, 2000).

This study was based on the specimens collected by Light Trap at the woods of Quercus spp. in Kangwon National University Experiment Forest from July to August, 2000.

Camptorhinus dorsalis (Boisduval) and Camptorhinus dorsonigritus Morimoto is separated from the fallowing characters.

Camptorhinus dorsalis (Boisduval): Pronotum rounded laterally and convex dorsally, fore tibiae with long hairs in mail.

Camptorhinus dorsonigritus Morimoto: Fore thiae without long hairs in mail. Pronotum shape is same in male and female.
