## 1-2. A New Genus *Mycterothrips* (Terebrantia: Thysanoptera) from Pakistan

Genus *Mycterothrips* belongs to the family Thripidae. Some member of this genus are known to be gall formers. This genus and one species M. nilgiriensis with both male and female specimens has been recorded for the first time from Pakistan. Both the sexes show marked differences in their antennal shape particularly the A6. The entire length of antenna in case of female is 299.98  $\mu m$  as against A6 length in males which alone is 215.13  $\mu m$ . The genus and the species have been described in detail, measurements of body parts along with illustrations have also been provided for future references. Thus adding to the list of Thysanoptera fauna from Pakistan.
