1-4. New Faunistic Records of Korean Noctuidae (Lepidoptera)

The Noctuidae is one of the large families among the order Lepidoptera and have the economic importance representing with several notorious pests on Agriculture and Forest. The Korean Noctuidae was enumerated with 965 species by Kononenko et al. (1998) and Sohn & Ronkay (2001). In the present study, three noctuid species new to Korea; Sinarella itoi Owada, Orthogonia basimacula (Draudt), Hypersypnoides submarginata (Walker), are recorded and the additional records of three little known species are provided. Especially, Among them, the female of Anatatha basinigra Kononenko et Ahn, an endemic noctuid, is described for the first time. Thus, the known Korean Noctuidae are 968 species. The genitalia of those newly recognized noctuids are figured and distributional notes are provided.
