

**1-5. *Stenamamma koreanensis*, sp. n. from the Korean Peninsula  
(Hymenoptera: Formicidae: Myrmicinae)**

A new species of the ant genus *Stenamamma* is described from the Korean peninsula. This new species is compared with related species; this is the second record of any *Stenamamma* species from the Korean peninsula; the first from South Korea. Keys for the separation of workers are revised to include this new species. Disposition of type specimens is provided
