

## 1-10. Taxonomy of the Larvae of Trichoptera from Vietnam

The Trichoptera is a relatively large group of aquatic insects containing about 10,000 known species in the world and showing the highest degree of diversity in Southeast Asia. The larvae are major components of stream ecosystems as primary consumers. The Vietnamese Trichoptera has been studied by Ulmer (1907), Navas (1917~1932), Mosely (1932), Olah (1987~1989), Mey (1995~1998), and Malicky (1994~1998), and 226 species (mainly adults) are known.
