1-15. Taxonomy of the Subgenus *Agathidium* of the Genus *Agathidium* Panzer in Korea (Coleoptera: Leiodidae: Leiodinae)

A taxonomic study of the subgenus Agathidium of the genus Agathidium Panzer in Korea is presented. The subgenus Agathidium has the following features: body 2.6~4.3 mm, shining, convex, can roll their body as a ball in most species, lateral margin of elytra with weak or rounded humeral angle, metasternum with distinct femoral lines, tarsal formula 5-5-4 in male, 5-4-4 in female, aedeagus with median foreman elongated and curved. Five species [Agathidium (Agathidium) coreanum Angelini, crassicorne Portevin, mequignoni Roubal, merkli Angelini, oblongum Angelini] are recognized in Korea. However, A. (A.) mequignoni Roubal is considered as a synonym of A. (A.) crassicorne Portevin. One species [A. (A.) crassicorne Portevin] is reported for the first time in Korea. Similarities and differences between five species, and pictures and illustrations of diagnostic characters of the species are presented.
