Six Species of the Genus *Ancylis* Hübner (Lepidoptera: Tortricidae: Eucosmini) New to China

During the course of the study on the the family Tortricidae in the Northeast China, we found six newly recorded species of the genus *Ancylis* H. from China. Morphological characteristics of them are briefly redescribed with illustrations of adults and genitalia. Also the known biological informations and distributional ranges for the species are mentioned.

The newly recorded species are as follows:

- 1. Ancylis mandarinana Walsingham, 1900 (Neimenggu)
- 2. Ancylis melanostigma Kuznetsov, 1970 (Heilongjiang)
- 3. Ancylis partitana (Christoph, 1881) (Neimenggu)
- 4. Ancylis repandana Kennel, 1901 (Heilongjiang)
- 5. Ancylis uncella ([Denis et Schiffermuller], 1775) (Neimenggu)
- 6. Ancylis upupana (Treitschke, 1835) (Heilongjiang, Neimenggu)
