

**A New species and Three unrecorded species of  
*Zanclognatha* Lederer (Lepidoptera, Noctuidae)  
from China**

Herminiine moths in China had been reported by various authors, with nine species belonging to six genera by Bryk (1949), by Draudt (1950, 38 species of 13 genus), by Chu, *et. al.* (1963, 2 species of 2 genus), by Chu, *et. al.* (1964, 13 species of 8 genus), and by Chen (1982, 1985, 1991, 1999, 91 species of 20 genera). In the Mt. Changbai (China part), 7 species belonging to 5 genera were recently reported by Wu *et al.* (1999). From a recent survey during 2000-2003 by authors, 23 species of the subfamily Herminiinae were recognized. Among them, a new species which is very closed to *Zanclognatha lunalis* (Scopoli) was collected Changbai-xian and Erdaobaihe. And three species (*Paracolax fentoni* (Butler), *Sinarella japonica* (Butler), *S. cristulalis* (Staudinger)) are reported for the first time from China.
