

# A Review of the Small Carpenter Bees, Genus *Ceratina* (Hymenoptera: Apidae) in Korea

Five species of the small carpenter bees, the genus *Ceratina* Latreille, are recognized in Korea, including a new species. The new species, *Ceratina (Ceratinidia) jejuensis* sp. n., was collected exclusively from Jeju Island. It belongs to the *C. (Ceratinidia) flavipes*-group, and is easily distinguished from the other species of this group, *C. (Ceratinidia) flavipes* Smith 1879, *C. (Ceratinidia) maai* Shiokawa 1982, and *C. (Ceratinidia) takasagona* Shiokawa 1982, by the characteristic colour patterns of head, clypeus, thorax and metasoma, and the shape of sternal teeth and apical lobes on sixth metasomal segment. *Ceratina (Ceratina) iwatai* Yasumatsu 1936 is reported for the first time in the Korean Peninsula.
