A Review of the Small Carpenter Bees, Genus *Ceratina* (Hymenoptera: Apidae) in Korea

Five species of the small carpenter bees, the genus Ceratina Latreille, are recognized in Korea, including a new species. The new species, Ceratina (Ceratinidia) jejuensis sp. n., was collected exclusively from Jeju Island. It belongs to the C. (Ceratinidia) flavipes-group, and is easily distinguished from the other species of this group, C. (Ceratinidia) flavipes Smith 1879, C. (Ceratinidia) maai Shiokawa 1982, and C. (Ceratinidia) takasagona Shiokawa 1982, by the characteristic colour patterns of head, clypeus, thorax and metasoma, and the shape of sternal teeth and apical lobes on sixth metasomal segment. Ceratina (Ceratina) iwatai Yasumatsu 1936 is reported for the first time in the Korean Peninsula.
