

# Periodontal–Restorative Interface with a Special Emphasis on Esthetics

The topic of lecture would include the following aspects :

- 1) Soft and hard tissue grafting for anterior esthetics
- 2) Esthetic restorative design criteria for altered periodontal environment

Currently in Japan, the ratio of patients with periodontitis is very high. As a result, we are seeing increases in the number of patients who have lost tooth and periodontal tissue, which has increased the opportunity to perform soft and hard tissue grafting for esthetic restorations, to say nothing of implant therapy.

In this presentation, I would like to discuss the regeneration of soft and hard tissues, which is indispensable for esthetic restorations.

Furthermore I would like to discuss the esthetic design criteria for altered periodontal environment, such as loss of interproximal papillae, ridge defect, long clinical crown with exposed root surface, etc...

In terms of established methods as well as new methods, by presenting the effects and long term treatment results.
