

Bibliographical Study about Pulse Diagnosis Areas and Assignment of Meridians in Horses.

Purpose: The relational study between humans and horses about palpation areas for pulse diagnosis and assignment of meridians.

Materials and Methods: We studied the relativity of pulse diagnosis between humans and horses through the scripts of Sin pyeon jip seong ma ui bang, Ma gyeong cho jip eon hae, Won hyeong ryo ma jip, Nae kyeong, Nan kyeong.

Results: The pulse diagnosis areas in carotid artery of horses was progressed from Inyeongmaek in scripts of Nae kyeong and the assignment of meridians for six pulse diagnosis areas was progressed from Chongumaek in scripts of Nankyeong.

Conclusion: The pulse diagnosis areas and assignment of meridians in horses was similar to humans' method. That might suggest method of pulse diagnosis in other animals.
