

Distribution of Resource Plants in Mt. ManRoi(ChungBuk), Korea

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ABSTRACT

This study was performed to investigate the resources flora of Mt. ManRoi(611.7m; 37° 51' N, 127° 20'E), during April 1995 to September 1998. The vascular plants, which were collected from the mountain were composed of all 382 taxa including cultivated species, and classified into 1 phylum, 4 classes, 34 orders, 87 families, 254 genera, 323 species, 1 subspecies, 55 varieties and 4 forms. There were not rare and endangered species, while 7 taxa of Korean endemic plants, that is, *Tricytis dilatata*, *Clematis trichotoma*, *Deutzia coreana*, *Spiraea prunifolia var. simpliciflora*, *Forsythia koreana*, *Weigela subsessilis* and *Patrinia sanicalaefolia* were distributed in this mountain. The vegetation of this investigated area is regarded as the boundary of the temperate middle part and temperate southern part in floral zone of the Korean Peninsula.

INTRODUCTION

Mt. ManRoi(611.7m; 37° 51' N, 127° 20'E) is located on the boundary between ChungNam Province, ChonAn City and ChungBuk Province, JinChon County. Ministry of Environment(1988) reported 300 taxa of Mt. Muje(573.7m) for the flora of JinChon County. The flora of all territory of JinChon County was reported 423 and 421 taxa by Ministry of Environment(1994a) and Office of JinChon County(1994), respectively. However, the surveyed area of past investigations was not Mt. ManRoi but another area far from this Mountain.

On the other hand, the reduction of natural resource caused by population increase is one of the world's

greatest problems. Therefore, it is important that research for the protection and conservation of natural resources must be done (Kang et al., 1999; 2000). To set bounds for useful resources is very difficult. Plant uses are enormous. Hence, it is imperative to explore plants' utilization as a resource.

The purpose of this study was to examine and present the composition of resources vascular plants and provide an information for conservation and preservation of resource plants in Mt. ManRoi, Korea.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

This study was conducted in Mt. ManRoi (611.7 m; 37° 51' N, 127° 20' E) in ChungBuk Province, Korea. The field survey of resource plants composition was

conducted from April 1995 to August 1998.

The yearly average temperature of study area was 12.2°C, 37.8°C as maximum and 19.3°C as Minimum. The range of a thermometer was 57.1°C. Annual precipitation average was 1,223.4mm in resent 10 years (Korea Meteorological Administration, 1998; Table 1).

Korean endemic and cultivated plants were marked '(E)' and '(C)' in their scientific name, respectively. The classification and scientific name were based according to Lee (1980). Korean endemic plants (Lee, 1984), rare and endangered plants (KACN, 1981; Ministry of Environment, 1994b) and usage of each plant (Kim, 1995; Yoon, 1995; Kim, 1996; Lee, 1996a; Lee, 1996b; Tae, 1998) were examined.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

1. Composition of resource plants

Vascular plants were identified in this study 382 taxa

with 87 families 254 genera 323 species 1 subspecies 55 varieties and 4 forms (Appendix). Such data represented 9.1% of Korean vascular plants of which 4,191 taxa were identified (Nakai, 1952). The flora of Mt. ManRoi consisted of 8 families Pteriophyta with 14 genera 20 taxa; 3 families Gymnospermae with 7 genera 9 taxa and 76 families Angiospermae with 233 genera 353 taxa, respectively (Table 2, 3).

2 Composition of plants for each use

The usefulness of plants was classified as edible 208 taxa (54.3%), medical 170 taxa (44.4%), pasture 112 taxa (29.2%), ornamental 50 taxa (13.1%), industrial 10 taxa (2.6%) and fiber 2 taxa (0.5) in this study. It revealed that plants identified could be grouped in terms of their usefulness such as edible, Medical, Ornamental, and so on. Significant finding showed that 45 taxa (11.7%) of plants in this mountain (Table 3) whose value is not yet known. With these data, more plants'

utilization could be identified in the future.

3. Remarkable plants in Mt. ManRoi

Korean endemic plants were 642 species, 40 varieties and 74 forms totally 1,118 taxa of endemic plants identified (Nakai, 1952). Likewise, Lee (1984) reported that there were 61 families, 172 genera, 339 species, 46 varieties and 22 forms totally 407 taxa, which are endemic. There were no rare and endangered species, while 7 taxa of Korean endemic plants, that is, *Tricyrtis dilatata*, *Clematis trichotoma*, *Deutzia coreana*, *Spiraea prunifolia* var. *simpliciflora*, *Forsythia koreana*, *Weigela subsessilis* and *Patrinia sanicalaefolia* were distributed in this mountain (Table 4).
