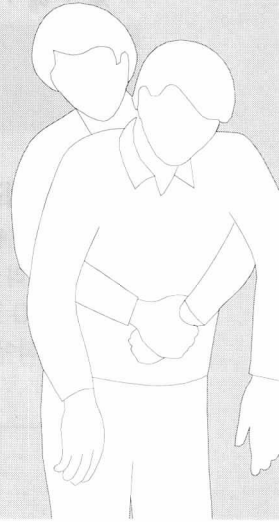
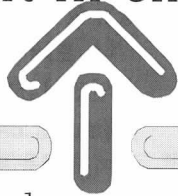

5 Minute Safety Meeting

Minutes count in emergencies



An emergency in a confined space can kill an entrant in a matter of minutes.

OSHA requires rescue systems or methods that allow rescuers to save workers without having to enter the space.

Tripods and winches are often used.

When a non-entry rescue is impossible, a rescuer must be prepared to enter the space.

The best policy for emergencies is to prevent them :

- Be sure atmospheric monitoring equipment is accurately calibrated.
- Leave the space immediately if hazardous conditions are detected.
- Coordinate entry operations when employees of more than one company are involved.
- Never use pure oxygen to ventilate a confined space - high levels of oxygen can cause flammable materials to spontaneously ignite and burn.
- Provide ample lighting that is safe for use in hazardous atmospheres.
- Use grounded, insulated electrical equipment.
- Vent equipment exhaust to a location outside the work area.
